Bub's taking more notice in gammon and real life things.

Bubs are learning how things work and can see the tricky side of things.

Bub's yarnin more — at least 3 words in a sentence.

If you read more books, they'll know more words and yarn more.

How can you help bub learn?

Ask bub about stories. What's happening? Why? What's next?

When bub asks you questions, try to take time to answer.

Sit, play and work out puzzles and games with bub.

When you go out, yarn about common signs and symbols that you see.

Yarn, dance and sing lots of action songs with the mob.

Help bub's hands get ready to write.

Play with balls, sand, playdough, brushes, blocks.

Meet and play with other bubs at playgroup, pre-school or childcare.
